

SWEEP Job Announcement: Program Associate, Building Efficiency

Description: The Southwest Energy Efficiency Project (SWEEP) is seeking a Program Associate to be located either in its Boulder, CO office or in the metro Denver area. The Program Associate will work on energy efficiency in buildings, reporting to our Buildings Program Director. The responsibilities for this position include:

- Assist with the analysis and advocacy of state-of-the-art building energy codes and appliance efficiency standards;
- Participate in the code adoption process and testify on code change proposals;
- Provide technical assistance and advice to state, cities, and utilities that are implementing programs to increase energy efficiency in residential and commercial buildings;
- Research new and emerging energy efficiency technologies for buildings and evaluate their energy savings potential and applicability in the Southwest;
- Write status reports, technical summaries, articles, white papers, and presentations;
- Organize and plan meetings and workshops, and provide technical presentations when requested; and
- Conduct outreach to raise awareness and increase the adoption of energy efficiency measures in new homes and commercial buildings in the Southwest.

Qualifications: Applicants should have experience working on energy efficiency in buildings for a private company such as a consulting or building industry firm, public agency, utility, public interest group, or research institution. Masters degree plus at least three years of experience, or Bachelors degree plus at least five years of experience. Strong analytical and communications skills, ability to work independently.

The candidate should also have experience working with building department staff, experience using energy modeling software, knowledge of building energy codes, and knowledge of voluntary energy efficiency programs such as ENERGY STAR, Builders Challenge, and LEED. The applicant should also have a personal commitment to a cleaner environment and more sustainable future. Experience working for a non-profit organization is also a plus.

Compensation: Salary commensurate with experience, plus excellent benefits, as well as the opportunity to work in a relaxed environment close to the mountains in Colorado.
