AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 9, CHAPTER 7, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 9-807; RELATING TO MUNICIPAL ENERGY CODES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 9, chapter 7, article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
3 amended by adding section 9-807, to read:

4 9-807. Municipal energy code for commercial buildings: adoption

5 A. WITHIN TWELVE MONTHS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION, A
6 MUNICIPALITY SHALL ADOPT THE 2003 INTERNATIONAL ENERGY CONSERVATION CODE FOR
7 COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS AS AMENDED BY THE 2004 SUPPLEMENT TO THE INTERNATIONAL
8 CODE WITH SPECIFIC REFERENCE TO THE AMERICAN SOCIETY OF HEATING,
9 REFRIGERATING AND AIR CONDITIONING ENGINEERS ENERGY STANDARD (ASHRAE/IESNA
10 STANDARD 90.1-2004) AS THE MUNICIPALITY'S ENERGY CODE FOR COMMERCIAL
11 BUILDINGS.

12 B. A MUNICIPALITY MAY ADOPT AMENDMENTS TO THE CODE THAT ARE MORE
13 STRINGENT THAN THE CODE THAT IS ADOPTED AS PRESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION A.
